ATHLETICS

All personal items must be clearly marked with camper's name.

TENNIS

- 1 Tennis Racquet w/Cover (**Required**)

OPTIONAL SPORTS EQUIPMENT

- 1 Helmet w/ Face Shield (**Required if participating-Can use lax helmet**)
- 1 Knee / Shin Guard Unit (**Required if participating**)
- 1 Set of Elbow Pads (**Required if participating**)
- 1 Set of Hockey Gloves (**Required if participating-Can use lax gloves**)
- 1 Hockey Stick (Optional)
- 1 Mouthguard
- 1 Athletic Supporter w/Cup
- 1 Mouthguard with case
- 1 Pair of Roller Blades (Optional)
- 1 Rollerblade Helmet
- 1 Lacrosse Gloves
- 1 Lacrosse Stick
- 1 Mouthguard (Attached to helmet)
